All concerned stakeholders, including aspiring pharmacists, educational institutions, and registered professionals, are hereby notified that the Manipur State Pharmacy Council (MSPC) has observed a rising trend of irregularities in the submission of documents for registration under the Pharmacy Act, 1948, and allied regulations. Such malpractices undermine the integrity of the pharmacy profession and pose serious risks to public health and safety.

1. **Irregular Documents:** Incomplete, tampered, or non-compliant application forms and supporting documents that do not meet the prescribed formats or requirements as per MSPC guidelines.
2. **Fake Certificates:** Submission of forged or fabricated certificates, including mark sheets, diplomas, or degrees from unauthorized sources.
3. **Improper Verification from Colleges:** Lack of authentic endorsements or verifications from parent institutions, including discrepancies in institutional seals, signatures, or attestations.
4. **Fake University Certificates:** Use of counterfeit degrees or provisional certificates issued in the name of recognized universities, without due authentication from the issuing authority.

Consequences of Non-Compliance:

- **Immediate Rejection:** Any previous, current and upcoming application found to contain the aforementioned irregularities will be summarily rejected without prejudice to further action.

- **Legal Action:** Perpetrators will face stringent penal provisions under the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) (Sections 420, 465, 468, and 471) for forgery, cheating, and criminal breach of trust, in addition to disciplinary measures under the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) regulations.

- **Blacklisting:** Individuals and institutions involved will be permanently blacklisted from MSPC registration processes. No future applications or endorsements will be entertained.

- **Fines and Penalties:** Monetary fines up to ₹5,00,000 (Rupees Five Lakhs) may be imposed, along with mandatory reporting to higher authorities such as the PCI and law enforcement agencies.

Applicants are urged to ensure utmost diligence in document preparation to avoid delays in registration. For queries or clarifications, contact the MSPC Registration Cell at the address above or via email.

This notification is issued in the exercise of powers conferred under Section 32 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, and shall come into effect immediately. Wide publicity is directed among all pharmacy colleges, hospitals, and professional associations in Manipur.
